## **Group Meetings**

- -Only parish organizations may meet at the church, and all group meetings will take place in the Parish Hall.
- -Call the parish office ahead of time to schedule all meetings. No more than one meeting per day will be allowed in the parish hall for all organizations.
- -All persons attending a parish organization meeting are to use the lower parking area and enter through the east-side glass doors of the hall. (*Please do not enter through the front church doors.*)
- -No groups will be allowed to enter any of the classrooms/classroom areas. If designated areas are needed in the Parish Hall for PSR use, they will be marked off.
- -No groups are allowed to use the stairs or elevator. Group activities will remain in the Parish Hall.
- -No groups are allowed to congregate in the hallways downstairs.
- -Bathroom doors will remain propped open to help avoid touching surfaces.

## Food, Beverages, and Social Events

- -No food is allowed.
- -No groups will be allowed to use the kitchen or kitchen materials. The doors will be locked.
- -Beverages will not be provided by the parish. Water fountains will continue to be turned off.
- -Groups hosting must bring their own beverages, coolers and/or beverage containers.
- -Funeral dinners will be suspended until further notice.
- -All parish festivals and socials are cancelled until further notice.

## Safety Protocols

Whoever is running the meeting is responsible to make sure the following rules are followed:

- -Participants of the group must wear a mask at all times while in the church building.
- -Participants of the group must enter the building using the downstairs alcove doors.
- -Participants must sanitize hands when they enter the building.
- -Participants should keep 6 feet of distance between one another at all times.
- -Participants are not allowed to wander the room or halls, but should remain seated as much as possible during the meeting. Overall movement should be kept to a minimum.
- -Participants must disinfect the chairs and tables used at the end of their meeting. Disinfecting supplies will be provided by the parish.
